Hello All,

At its May 28th meeting, Ad Council decided to advertise to the congregation the creation of a committee whose main task would be to organize the beginning of a discernment process at Ono about Ono's future. I will lead this group as Lay Leader. The 2 most immediate actions of this group will be to: 1) organize a presentation to the congregation about what happened at the UMC 2024 General Conference, and 2) host a congregational meeting at which time this presentation will be given. Desirably, the committee would have volunteer members from both congregations, both young and old, and both men and women.
