ONO CHURCH DISCERNMENT

After hearing feedback from the group who organized the July discernment meetings and the survey results of those who attended the meetings, the Ono Church Administrative Council voted at its July meeting to schedule a church membership meeting and vote on the question of Ono Church's future with the United Methodist denomination.

On **Tuesday September 24**, **at 7 pm in the sanctuary**, the Administrative Council will hold its regular bi-monthly meeting as well as conduct a Charge Conference. A Charge Conference is a meeting of all members of Ono Church. The question of seeking a separation from the United Methodist denomination will be the focus of the Charge Conference. Any member wishing to vote will need to be in attendance for the discussion and vote.

HOLY CONFERENCING: On September 24th, Ono UMC will hold a charge conference. Many people have asked about voting without being present at the meeting. The concept of a conference is well rooted in the idea of "holy conferencing." It is a trust that as we gather together, God's presence is there to lead us! Therefore, it is not simply a vote, but an opportunity for us to trust the Holy Spirit at work in our community. That is why you need to be present. This is not a governmental decision, but a Holy one. All of us should make our hearts available to the Holy Spirit to lead and guide us in that moment. I love the idea of Holy Conferencing. While I understand people's desire to have a vote, I prefer we trust the Holy Spirit to move in our midst. I hope to see you participating in our Holy Conference as we allow the Holy Spirit to lead us into the future!
