On **Tuesday September 24, at 7 pm in the sanctuary**, the Administrative Council will hold its regular bi-monthly meeting as well as conduct a Charge Conference. A Charge Conference is a meeting of all members of Ono Church. The question of seeking a separation from the United Methodist denomination will be the focus of the Charge Conference. Any member wishing to vote will need to be in attendance for the discussion and vote.
