In a mountain community in Ghana a tractor transported containers filled with shoebox gifts to the mountaintop. OCC leader George said "We want to reach kids with these shoe box gifts. This is the first time these children have been presented with the Gospel." Children in the villages were thrilled to receive so many gifts in their shoe box – a tangible expression of God's love for them. This was the first time that most of them had ever received a present. Tetteh, 14, said that her favorite items inside the shoebox were a notebook, pencils, and erasers. "I'm happy and excited to have all of this. I wouldn't know how to get these things."

OCC is a powerful gateway to a community. The gift boxes help to gain entry, and once you do, you can keep going with the discipleship material because you have earned their trust and built a relationship

There are lawsuits, meetings with the Bishop, a resolution to be presented at the next annual conference, etc. While this process might take a couple years, we want to stay focused on mission and ministry. We will keep the congregation informed if there are any developments, but in the meantime, we ask that you keep the congregation and your leaders in prayer. Pray for wisdom, peace and justice. Pray that our congregation would remain committed to loving all people and to the missions and ministries that God is calling us to do for Him. Pray for one another that we would maintain the fellowship that has carried us over the years. Finally, remain focused on God's presence to lead and guide us all into the future.
